There has been a lot of work going on in the parish over the spring and early summer. In particular, I want to thank the members of the 'Connections Group'. They met over a number of months to work on our presentation of written items and how we communicate within and outside of our churches. We now have a standard typeface and style for all written items – you are looking at it in this newsletter, and we have been using it for our pewsheets too. They group also worked on a parish logo, which is on the front of this newsletter, and which you will begin to see used in our churches. The group generated lots of ideas, which will result in future activities, and we are grateful to them for their time and energy.

Vision process

As we go to press, we have just had a PCC meeting, in which we started a 'Vision Process' for our parish, thinking about where God might be leading us as a Christian community over the next three or four years. A similar process happened in 2001, and was reworked in a different way during the vacancy, as you thought about what you were wanting from a new vicar. This is a process for us all to engage in, and there will be opportunities to feed in your thoughts. Each church will have a 'Vision Evening', with time for prayer, reflection and discussion. These will be advertised, so do look out for them and come if you can. A verse to use in your prayers for this process comes from Psalm25:
