Gift Aid

The parish has benefited greatly from the Gift Aid scheme since it was first introduced in April 2000. In 2007 we received income tax repayments totalling £5200. We had feared that the reduction in the basic rate of income tax from 22% to 20% as from 6th April 2008 would result in a significant reduction in our income from the Exchequer. But fortunately in his Budget statement the Chancellor has announced that transitional relief will be introduced for the next 3 years, which will leave us no worse off.

Please bear this in mind when thinking and praying about how much you give. Now is a very good time to ensure that your giving is tax efficient and Church treasurers will be happy to offer any advice you need. Experience shows that planned giving by Banker's standing order, either monthly quarterly or annually, is particularly helpful when budgeting for the maintenance and growth of the work of the church in these two dales.
