From the Vicarage

My Advent reading for this year is The Meaning is in the Waiting, by Paula Gooder. You may recognise the title as a quote from the last line of R.S. Thomas' poem 'Kneeling', which talks about being still and meeting with God 'in a stone church in summer.'

The author writes, If we want to appreciate Advent fully we need to re-learn how to wait, to rediscover the art of savouring the future, of staying in the present and of finding meaning in the act of waiting.

She makes the point that actively waiting through Advent allows us to 'anticipate' Christmas properly, rather than rushing towards it from the moment the 'Back to School' displays come down and the tinsel appears in the shops, usually sometime in September.

Waiting, rather than being a waste of time, can be a creative and reflective experience. Taking time to appreciate the season of Advent for itself means that we can come to Christmas with fresh eyes. We can slow down and be still enough to full of wonder again at God's coming among us in his Son Jesus, the fulfilment of his promise in his perfect time.

Make time for the journey of Advent in small ways. One way is to read the Christmas story from the Bible, slowly, and then reflect on a verse or two through each day. Another way to mark Advent is in lighting a candle and saying a prayer each day, perhaps as you sit down to eat. These are modest beginnings, but will mark the journey. Advent will become richer and full of meaning, and Christmas will come, not as a rush, but as an eagerly awaited season of joy.
