From the Vicarage

Why is Easter so early this year? It has caused problems for school holidays, and I have had a few discussions with people who have asked why it is not a fixed date.

The calculation of Easter is that it is the first Sunday after the Full Moon that occurs on or after the vernal equinox (which, for this purpose is always assumed to be on March 21). If the full moon falls on a Sunday then Easter is the next Sunday. This means that the date of Easter can vary by up to a month from 22 March and that Easter this year is almost the earliest possible date that it can be.

Easter is a moveable feast, based on the lunar (moon) calendar, like the Jewish festivals. This links it in with the Jewish Passover, the background of much of the biblical account of the death of Jesus.

The gospel writers pick up and use the Passover themes to explain what Jesus' death and resurrection is all about. These include suffering, the sinless lamb sacrificed for sin, and the Exodus story of God the rescuer taking his people from slavery to freedom. Against this background, the Easter story points to Jesus as the fulfilment of the promises of God that he would send a Saviour to redeem people and to bring them the hope of new and eternal life.

Happy Easter - Christ is Risen!
