## From the Vicarage

As I write, we are in the season of Harvest Festivals. Last year, at this time, we joined in the national campaign for 'Fair Trade for British Farmers'. That was an important marker, and raised the issue with a wider community, but this year has not been much easier for those who work the land and produce food.

Arable farmers have had their crops ruined by wind and rain, to the point where harvesting is almost impossible for some, because of flat crops and land too waterlogged to take machinery onto it. Those who raise sheep and cattle are looking at the arrival of Bluetongue into this country and wondering where it will all end.

Our Harvest Services must be realistic. There is no joy in singing 'all is safely gathered in', when it plainly is not, so in our Harvest services we will remember and pray for all our farmers in these difficulties, as well as giving thanks for God's provision for us.

We are also approaching a season of Remembering. There are details in this newsletter of the services for Remembrance Sunday and for an All Souls Service, which is for anyone who wants to come together with others to remember a loved one who has died. This is the first time we have held such a service for a number of years, and I hope it may become an annual event. Further details are in this newsletter; do contact me if you want to talk more about it.
