From the Vicarage - a Visit from the Vicar

It seems that there is some misunderstanding around about visits from the Vicar, so I want to make clear how these happen.

I am available to visit anyone who lives in this parish, either at their home or in hospital. At that time, I can listen to you, talk about the Christian faith with you and pray with and for you. You can also ask to receive Holy Communion at home if you are physically unable to get to church.

Some people assume that the doctor and hospitals inform the Vicar if someone is ill - this, of course, is <u>not</u> the case. That information is confidential and must be kept so. The only way that I know if you are ill and want me to visit is if you let me know.

You do not have to be a church member, and you do not have to be ill, to ask for the Vicar to visit you, but you do need to ask. I cannot know everyone's situation – and I certainly cannot guess whether or not you would want the Vicar to come and see you.

If you would like a visit, please contact me by phone or email, so that we can arrange a convenient time and date. I look forward to seeing you.
