Our theme for Harvest this year is Water for Life.

Water is essential for all life: here in John's gospel Jesus uses the powerful image of water to talk about the eternal life that he alone can give:

Jesus said ... 'Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty. The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life.' (from John 4)

This Harvest time, as a parish, we are supporting the work of The Busoga Trust, a charity which provides clean water to communities in Uganda.
