From the Vicarage

I am writing this the day after the Church of England General Synod failed to approve the legislation to allow women to become bishops. This was a surprise to some, and baffling to others.

On a world scale, this is the day that Israel and Gaza stopped throwing bombs at each other and declared a ceasefire, after days of bombardment and more than 150 people dead.

Sometimes we look at our world and wonder where God is and what will happen next. This applies in our own lives too, when things seem hard, and there appears to be no way to change a situation.

Christian faith can offer us a way. We are approaching Christmas, when we remember that Jesus came to live among us, to be just as we are, and to experience all that we know in life.

At Christmas services we will hear of Jesus, that 'the light shines in the darkness and the darkness did not overcome it.' (John 1:5)

A Chinese proverb reminds us that 'it is better to light a candle than to curse the darkness.' This can be a call to prayer for us; if you do not have the words to pray, light a candle, and know that God is present. *Emmanuel*, a name given to Jesus, meaning God is with is, is the promise of the season that we are about to celebrate.
