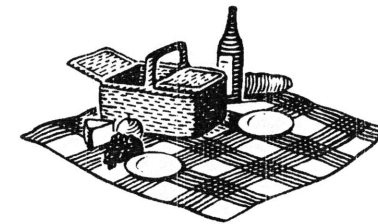

## From the Vicarage

At our **Annual Church Meeting** in April, we thought about the African idea of Ubuntu. This is expressed as 'I am who I am because we are'. In other words, we are part of a community and need to think in that way, not just as individuals, about all of life. This is also a Christian way of seeing life and community, which is very evident in the New Testament.

We took the following words - verses from I Corinthians 12 - as our Bible text for the year ahead:

*For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. Indeed, the body does not consist of one member but of many. Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.*

I encourage you to continue to think and pray and act on these words as we walk in faith together,
