Not 'from the Vicarage'...instead, a guest column from Sue Allatt, who has come to live in Grinton:

Caroline has suggested that I write a little bit about myself to explain what I am trying to do here.

Some of you will know that I have lived in a monastic community for the past 30 years. There are 2 kinds of monastic communities - active and contemplative - and my community was contemplative. This meant that the focus of our life was prayer and hospitality we did not have outside 'jobs' like teaching or nursing. However living in community can be quite 'busy' and I have increasingly felt drawn to a more solitary way of life with more time for prayer. I came up to Gunnerside last September for 3 months to see how this would feel. During that time I realised that God was now calling me to explore more deeply this life of prayer. I have been released from my community and am now living in a little cottage in Grinton. I live alone and have long times of quiet during the day for prayer. I have also been accustomed to getting up early and going to bed early and this too is part of my pattern of life.

You may wonder what living this kind of life actually means and indeed I am rather feeling my way, letting things unfold a bit and trying to be open to where God leads. For me it's about having more time and space in which to pray about, to hold, and to enter into the pain of the world in a deeper more focussed way.

One of the things I deeply believe is that God uses prayer in his own way in his broken world. Many times I wonder what, if anything, I am contributing to 'the body of Christ', but each time I come back to this belief that God is using the prayer. As we can only see a part of the tapestry of life (God seeing the whole) I have to accept that I will never know and that actually I don't need to know, the offering is what is important.

Although I am living this more 'alone' life, it is important for me to be part of the worshipping community here so that I can hold you in my prayers and so that, hopefully, you can hold me in yours. Also it doesn't mean that I don't speak to anyone - and it doesn't mean that I don't see friends occasionally - but I'm trying to structure my life so that God and prayer are truly at the centre and that does need time and space.
