On Easter Sunday, the Diocese of Ripon and Leeds will cease to exist in its current form, and we will become part of the *Diocese of West Yorkshire and the Dales*, which brings together the three former dioceses of Ripon and Leeds, Bradford and Wakefield.

By the end of February, we should know who will be the Bishop for the whole diocese; by the summer, we should have a Bishop in place in each of five smaller Episcopal areas. Our parish will be in the *Ripon Episcopal area*, with Bishop James Bell (whom we know well) as our local Bishop.

There will be updates about this in the pew sheets and on the website. Please <u>pray</u> for this huge reorganisation and for all of the implications that it has for mission and ministry across this wide area.
