

As we go to print, our newspaper reports and TV pictures are showing us human suffering on a grand scale. Thousands of people are on the move, displaced from their homes and countries, which have been destroyed through war, and are seeking a place of peace and safety.

People in need is not a new problem. Hundreds of years ago, the prophet Isaiah wrote these words, which may speak to us afresh as we meditate on them:

Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of injustice, to undo the thongs of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? "Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover them, and not to hide yourself from your own kin?...If you remove the yoke from among you, the pointing of the finger, the speaking of evil, "if you offer your food to the hungry and satisfy the needs of the afflicted, then your light shall rise in the darkness and your gloom be like the noonday." The LORD will guide you continually, and satisfy your needs in parched places, and make your bones strong; and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters never fail.
