STABILITY



This month, in place of a letter, we hear from Patsy Tyler about an experience that led to poetry:

The poem that follows was written during a retreat in April. The focus was *Prayer*, in the context of *A Benedictine Experience*, with sessions to study and discuss the Benedictine vows of *Stability*, *Conversion of Life and Obedience*.

During free time on the first full day, I attempted to write a poem incorporating what had been learned about Stability, but the poem refused to be constricted by a carefully pre-planned rigid structure. It was only when I let go of the need for control and listened attentively to the heart that the poem emerged in its present form, carrying with it a message that spoke so strongly to the other participants that they insisted on taking copies home. Some asked for permission to include it in their parish magazines, and I was urged to submit it for this newsletter.

Surprisingly, over the next two days, it became clear that all three vows are intricately woven together and that the nature of all three is contained within the poem. In effect, through writing the poem and dealing with the inner conflicts that arose when asked to part with it, I was gifted invaluable experience of those vows, (which I now understand to be the very qualities essential to life in Christ), and the opportunity graciously to share with others. Christ set me free, And built a sturdy base to rest upon; That could withstand whatever life would send. But when Life called, I met Him with a handstand; And when I fell, I wondered what it was that I'd done wrong!

He didn't say - although He could have done -'You silly girl, why don't you listen? I've taught you everything That you should need to journey on: I don't expect habitual reaction; What I command is living, giving action from the heart in Love.'

No. What my Lord said was: 'You are my Beloved – My Love is yours forever; night and day. Just learn the meaning of stability: Stand firm in Faith; just persevere; and Let Life be what Life will be.

And if you fall, It will be I that picks you up again, And puts you back upon More steady feet; But you won't always know it's me that lifted you – Unless, of course, You see My eyes in everyone you meet!
